TCRC General Chairmen have sent out a negotiation bulletin explaining that considering the eminent appointment of an Arbitrator by the government they came to an agreement with Company and opted for interest arbitration. This afforded them the best chance of a fair settlement considering that they will be part of the selection process in regards to the Arbitrator and there are no preconditions set out for the final award. The General Chairmen (Bargaining Committee) have spent the time following the strike preparing for the mediation-arbitration process. A negotiated contract was their goal, but they are ready and committed to presenting the Union's demands before a third party.
