Secretary/Treasurer's Report

Following is the Sec/Tres report for our September Meeting.

Just a friendly reminder that our yearly dues for September 2025 to May 2026 of \$10.00 are now due. You can either pay at the meeting or e-transfer to me at nrdionne1953@gmail.com

Welcome back everyone and I hope you had a great summer. At our last meeting in May we had 22 members present with 13 joining us for lunch.

Finances — expenses for the month of May were Legion for 13 meals \$156.00. Lucky winners of our door prizes were Gary Cook and Mark Wardle who received \$20.00 each and our association received \$22.00. On May 27th I deposited \$180.00. We currently have \$129.00 cash on hand and our Bank balance is \$6509.57.

From June 5th to June 7th, I attended the NCCPPA convention in Calgary as a delegate from London. I will make available a copy of the minutes of the meetings once they become available.

Expenses that I incurred while attending these meetings were as follows, flight from London to Calgary and return \$564.37 and hotel room at the Glenmore Convention Centre for 3 nights \$297.57, for a total of \$861.94.

As per Article VII Section 2 of the Convention bylaws any Association with less than 100 members can apply for assistance to help offset the expenses of the delegate to attend.

The amount of assistance was increased from \$400.00 to \$600.00 at the convention so therefore I am submitting an expense of \$261.94 for attending the convention. I also purchased a package of blank membership cards at a cost of \$27.11. My wife has agreed to print them free of charge. The last time I purchased 250 printed signs from Bolt Signs the cost was \$97.11 so there is a substantial savings.

Nominations will be accepted at the September meeting for the following officers President, Vice-President, Secretary/ Treasurer and Delegate to the Triennial Convention. Election will be held at the October meeting if necessary.
